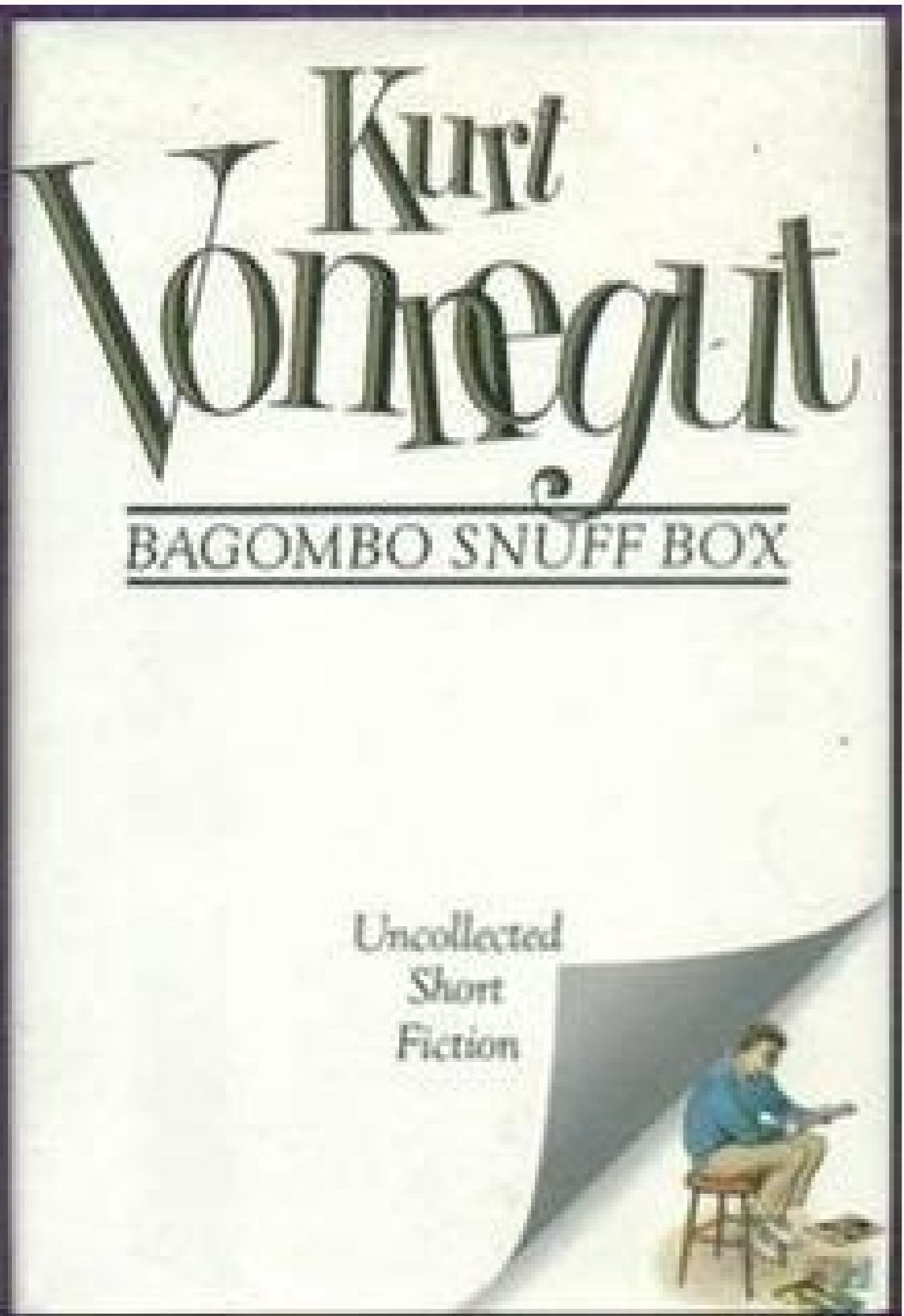
Preface

The Crucible

This passage is based on Act 2 from Reverend Hale's entry to his exit. Taken from 'The Crucible' by Arthur Miller.

The Crucible by Arthur Miller is a very complex and interesting book. Arthur Miller knows how to keep an audience captivated. The play was written during the period of American History commonly known as McCarthyism. Arthur Miller was convicted of being a communist sympathiser because he had signed a couple of petitions. What made Miller link these actions to the Salem witch-hunt was that the Salem investigations people were brought forward to confess being a communist sympathiser and forced to name other people who also were communist sympathisers.

McCarthy and his disciples all became just as paranoid as the Salem judges were. Any criticism was an offence of being a communist sympathiser. Therefore, for Arthur Miller the link between the Salem witch-hunt and the goings on at the time was crystal-clear. Arthur already had obtained knowledge of the witch-hunts from his college days and the subject was refreshed even more when he read 'The Devil in Massachusetts' by Marion Starkey.

In act two, Hale enters into the house at a crucial point it is when Elizabeth has shouted out 'She has an arrow in you yet John Proctor and you know it well'. Hale comes in and asks about why they have not been at

Though you don't have to know so much about the (narrative complex) period of world history, suffice it to say that these comments marked the start of **The Cold War** between America and the Soviet Union, and continued to have far-reaching consequences throughout the 20th century (e.g. American involvement in the Vietnam War was in large part due to their fear of the **Domino Theory**, which suggested that as each country in southeast Asia fell to Communism, more nations would follow the domino).

The hunt for Communists, or "**Reds under the bed!**" (since red is the color traditionally associated with Communism), and how red (which encompasses about 100 million people) were being systematically under people's beds" (the early industrial revolution) was largely dominated by conservative or right-wing politicians like Joseph McCarthy. Thus, it was a dangerous time for many left-leaning writers, artists, and activists, including Arthur Miller himself who was **arrested** as part of the Red movement.

In 1950, Arthur Miller was brought before the **House Un-American Activities Committee (HUAC)** as a direct response to his publishing of *The Crucible* three years prior. HUAC conducted investigations into people's Communist affiliations, and was particularly concerned with figures in Hollywood that were thought to be involved in activities with the Soviet Union. In order to affirm the morals of Americans, as various producers, writers, and directors were also asked to testify.

Many of the individuals mentioned or accused in this process became targets of strict surveillance and suspicion, and were very often discriminated against in their jobs and communities. Those who were indicted were made to choose between admitting their "allegiances" and surrendering their "conscience," or being criminally charged and, subsequently, having their names published and called. (Note that this situation does not resemble the allegations to Proctor during *The Crucible* either. He was either executed and executed his friends in return and lose his life.)

Meaning: This episode against communist influence in the United States and a major source of inspiration for Miller's play in which the themes of hysteria, intolerance, and fear he saw gloriously evident during these years are reproduced in Salem. Danforth could even be said to loosely represent McCarthy in his stubbornness, rigidity, and brutality.

Applied to: When Miller refused to give up the names of any of his colleagues who were communist sympathizers, he was fined, **imprisoned**, and sentenced to jail, though his conviction was overturned in 1955. This experience only served to strengthen Miller's sympathy for persecuted groups in society, and he spent the rest of his life working **compassionately** to victims of injustice, both in his literature and in his life.
